

Aimed squarely at those who see data analytics at the very core of the future of the project delivery profession. The advocates, pathfinders and champions. Some candidates will focus on becoming a practitioner, with aspirations ranging from supplementing their current skills through to driving the next generation of risk management, project controls or benefits management.

Those in leadership positions are likely to focus on a translator role. Identifying the business problems that analytics can help solve, guide teams and suppliers in the creation of analytics-driven solutions to these problems, tackling implementation obstacles and embedding solutions into the very heart of project delivery. They understand the art of the possible and how difficult it is because they have done it.

The watchword for people who sign up to this course is 'investment'. They tend to be invested in their career and personal development. They understand the power of data but lack the skills, knowledge and experience to be at the forefront of this movement. We help them to unlock their potential.
